WORK CONTEXT/ BACKGROUND:

The 7.8 magnitude earthquake and subsequent aftershocks that struck Nepal on 25 April 2015 have caused widespread displacement, extensive destruction of infrastructure and government reports of more than 7,900 deaths. There is an estimated 8.1 million people living in the 39 districts impacted. At least 940,000 children are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance, and those left homeless by the earthquake are particularly vulnerable. World Vision is responding to the urgent needs of an initial 100,000 beneficiaries with distribution of food and NFIs, and interventions in emergency shelter, health and nutrition, WASH, food security, and protection and education.
