- Strong communication skills both in Nepali and English.
- Passionate to serve the poor and marginalized people in the remote part of Nepal.
- Willing to work in a multi-cultural setting based in remote part of various districts of Nepal such as Mugu, Bajura, Banke, Kapilvastu, Gorkha etc. with frequent visits to selected VDCs.
- Good observation skill and learning attitude.
- Commit oneself to a 10-month full time internship programme
